

# THE CHAPEL

## A BEAUTIFUL CIRCULAR HALL

- The Chapel can hold 100 people seated in the round
- There is a grand piano and organ
- There are built in ceiling speakers and a 4-channel PA mixer with a lectern, Clip on and handheld wireless microphone
- The chapel has wonderful natural acoustics

## THE PERCIVAL SUITE

- The Percival Suite can hold 75 people seated theatre style or

64 people can be seated around 8 rectangular tables

- The Percival has a room divider so making one room with a capacity for 50 people the other will hold 15 people
- This room is next to the Kitchen and can be served through a hatch.

## THE KITCHEN

- The Kitchen has an electric oven with five rings
- A domestic dishwasher
- A double sink and Drainer
- 2 hot water urns and kettles
- A small domestic fridge
- A large assortment of crockery, cups, glasses, utensils, and serving dishes available as extra on request.

## **THE GASKELL ROOM**

Named after William Gaskell the husband of the novelist Elizabeth Gaskell, who was the Reverend of the Chapel from 1824 to 1888.

- This room is a small wood paneled room suitable for meetings of up to 10 people seated around a table.

## **THE KENWORTHY ROOM**

- This room holds up to 20 people in a variety of layouts.

## **THE BARRACLOUGH ROOM**

- This is a comfortable sitting room, with space for up to 6 people.

With access to a small kitchen. It could be suitable for counselling and therapy.

The whole building is served by fast fibre optic broadband Wi Fi.

We have 2 x projectors and a screen.

We have flip charts and flip chart paper.
